The Greek Pipeline of PPP projects 8 projects approved - 919 mil. Euros *

- 27 schools in Attica
- 31 schools in Central Macedonia
- 7 fire stations
- Conference center in Athens
- 3 prisons
- 2 courts of justice
- 6 University buildings in Peloponissos
- Facility management of 4 Police buildings

* Indicative Budget includes construction, maintenance and insurance cost



The Greek Pipeline of PPP projects more than 500 million Euros to follow

- Regional sport centers
- 2 Accommodation buildings for regional authorities
- 22 schools in East Macedonia and Thrace
- Ports adv. technology security system
