
Raw Materials & Emerging Economies


- Globalization is all about shipping
- ***** Emerging economies' growth is raw material intensive
- Demand for commodities at record levels
- **★** High commodity prices spur investment in mining projects
- * Raw material deposits easier to develop in emerging economies
- **★** Exploitation of deposits = growth = raw material demand = shipping demand
- ★ Even raw material rich countries have to import (China, India, Brazil)

- China is surrounded by mountains and underdeveloped areas
- ★ Due to its geographical position China has to import and export goods by sea
- That's why the coast-line has developed so rapidly










India & China Geographically Similar








Indian Coal Imports
