What is a Public Private Partnership ?





 - 5 pre-selected
 - PPP tender to be awarded in the 1st Q of 2008

- Surface: 53,000m²

 - Launch of the first PPP tender in December 2007





Facility Management in 4 buildings of the Hellenic Police



- Facility management (maintenance, E/M equipment, BMS, optimization of energy costs) for 15 years
- Budget (NPV): 36 M euros
- Contracting Authority: Greek Public Real Estate Corporation (<u>www.ked.gr</u>)
- Status
 - Launch of the PPP tender in the 1st Q of 2008





6 new Government Houses



- Financing, construction, maintenance, facility management for 25 years
- In 6 cities: Lamia, Patras, Trikala, Korinthos, Ioannina and Alexandroupoli
- Total Budget (NPV): 162 M euros Surface: 88,000m²
- 6 Contracting Authorities
 - 3 tenders
 - Status
 - Advisors' appointed
 - 1st tender in January 2008
